- Red-Purple Bypass opened in November 2021
- Southbound Red Line tracks between Belmont and Newport/Cornelia rebuild and completed in fall 2023
- Coming next: Rebuild northbound tracks through 2025

TWO YEARS OF RED-PURPLE BYPASS

Red-Purple Bypass opened in **NOVEMBER 2021**

UNCLOG RED, PURPLE, BROWN LINE

rail junction built in early 1900s

Allows entire CTA system to **RUN SMOOTHER**

INCREASE CAPACITY

for Red, Purple and Brown Line trains

NORTH BELMONT RED-PURPLE RECONSTRUCTION

- Completely reconstruct 100-year-old tracks and structure between W. Belmont Ave. and W. Cornelia Ave.
- Includes removing the track curve at W. Newport Ave. that restricts speed
 - New track structure is designed to allow trains to move quicker, more smoothly, and with less noise



NORTH BELMONT RED-PURPLE RECONSTRUCTION

- New closed deck structure and noise walls are designed to reduce train noise for residents and pedestrians
- Along with the Bypass, allows for more train capacity less crowding during rush periods

— Southbound tracks to be completed fall 2023





- No more than one major street closed at a time
- No more than two alleys closed
- Alternative parking for affected residents
- Garbage pickup to be maintained



OVERNIGHT WORK AND NOISE IMPACTS


- Loud noise and vibration will come from running heavy machinery and demolition activities
- Though some work will be required to follow a 24/7 schedule, the contractor will perform the noisiest activities during daytime hours whenever possible
- Noise mitigation techniques such as the use of sound blankets and sound barriers will be implemented as needed
- All loud activities will be monitored to be within limitations set by the contract


