Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. STREET & ALLEY CLOSURES

Dates: Wednesday, April 24 to Monday, May 6, 2024

Location:

- W. Grace Street at the CTA Tracks
- The alley behind 3755-3763 N. Sheffield Avenue & 3754-3764 N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm; continuous 24/7 alley closure
(Prep work will begin at least ½ hour prior to start of shift)

Work Activity: Drilled Shaft Installation & Equipment Demobilization

Local Impact:

W. Grace Street

- **W. Grace Street will be closed Friday, April 26 through Thursday, May 2, 2024.**
- **There will be short term daily street closures on W. Grace Street during Cubs home games (the street closure will be picked up at least 2 hours prior to first pitch).**
- W. Grace Street at the CTA Tracks will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic.
- Access to the parking lot at 954 W. Grace Street will be maintained at all times.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Grace Street, within the work zone, will be closed during stated work hours.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Grace Street will remain open at all times.

3755-3763 N. Sheffield Avenue & 3754-3764 N. Wilton Avenue

- Crews will block access to the alley and garages/parking spaces (including underneath the CTA tracks) until the work activity is completed.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.
