Brown Line Schedule Status & Problem Issues as of 4/10/08

Project Value/Total Budget	\$529.9M
Earned to Date	\$341.1M
Percent Earned to Date	64.4%
Percent Time Used to Date	62.0%

- 3-track operation southbound at Belmont and Fullerton and 8-car Brown Line service began on March 30, 2008.
- Southport Station and Diversey Temporary Station opened March 30, 2008.
- Paulina and Wellington Stations closed on March 30, 2008.

Percent Time Used to Date	71%

- Continued coordination with CDOT & local agencies for street closures/detours.
- Weekend single tracks affecting rail service between Friday night and Monday morning will continue through June 2008.
- Terminal scheduled for opening at end of May 2008 making station ADA accessible.




Subway Escalators Schedule Status & Problem Issues as of 4/10/08

- Project schedule was approved on 3/26/08.
- Submittals under review.
- Applied for building permits, held bid intake meeting, standard review process underway.

State Street Tie Replacement Schedule Status & Problem Issues as of 4/10/08

Total Project Budget	\$36.5M
Contract Value	\$26.6M
Earned to Date	\$1.5M
Percent Earned to Date	5%
Percent Time Used to Date	29%

- Demolition began 2/15/08 and as of 4/6/08, 5,942 ties have been removed.
- Pouring of concrete half ties began April 5, 2008 and 453 ties were poured.
- Project will utilize single track re-routes on a weekly basis with 4 to 6 double tube re-routes strategically offered to contractor to avoid lengthy construction slow zones and accelerate slow zone removal.

- Installed cab signals on the Congress Branch of the Blue Line from Forest Park to Western.
- Installed cab signals on the Kennedy Branch of the Blue Line from Jefferson Park to California. Armitage is scheduled for completion on April 30, 2008.

- Phase 2 project construction began March 28, 2008. Approximately 3,818 track feet were replaced during the weekend of March 28-30, 2008.
- During the weekend of April 4-6, 2008, approximately 3,960 track feet were replaced.
- ●Total track feet to complete in Phase 2 and Phase 3 is 81,776 feet.

Loop Signals Schedule Status & Problem Issues as of 4/10/08

Total Project Budget	\$78.8M
Contract Value	\$48.8M
Earned to Date	\$6.2M
Percent Earned to Date	12.7%
Percent Time Used to Date	43.8%

- The Final Block Design has been approved; installation of wayside signal equipment can begin.
- DBEC is installing train stops, signal platforms, and local signal cable in the Loop.
 DBEC will be installing conduit in the LaSalle Street Trolley Tunnel.
- Tower 18 work is currently scheduled for Fall 2009, but DBEC is attempting to accelerate this work to begin in Fall 2008. Tower 18 work will need to be coordinated with the construction of the new apartment building at the NW corner of Lake/Wells.
- A change order for the track renewal of the Lake/Wabash legs of the Loop is current scheduled for the April board meeting.
