


#### Federal Grant

- Participated with the City in application for USDOT Congestion Reduction Demonstration funding
- On April 29<sup>th</sup> Transportation Secretary Mary Peters announced with Mayor Daley that Chicago would receive \$153.1 million
  - Includes funds for BRT in 4 corridors
  - Purchase of articulated hybrid buses
- CTA and City will work together to apply for available funds
- To meet Federal requirements it will be necessary to do additional planning and public outreach






## Corridors


- Application locations based on the following criteria:
  - High average daily ridership
  - High potential to increase travel speed
  - High average customer trip length
  - Complements variable pricing strategy
    - Provides direct service to downtown area OR
    - Feeds downtown-oriented rail and express bus line
- Based on criteria analysis, 4 corridors selected
  - Jeffrey
  - Halsted
  - 79th Street
    - Chicago







### **Dedicated Lanes**




