We have a guorum. 13 CTTEE. CHAIR IRVINE: Thank you, Greq. 14 Our first order of business is the review 15 of minutes of the July 17, 2019, and January 15th, 16 2020, Committee minutes. The minutes were 17 previously distributed. 18 May I have a motion to approve? 19 DIRECTOR ALVA ROSALES: So moved. 20 Second. CHAIRMAN PETERSON: 21 MR. 13	of an ordinance authorizing an additional
14	experiment for Bus Route No. 31/31st. Mike
15	Connelly will be presenting.

17	MR. CONNELLY: Good morning. I'm Mike
18	Connelly, your Chief Planning Officer.
19	When we briefed Board members in February
20	about the ridership on this bus route, we were
21	very positive and excited due to the ridership
22	increases we had observed after the Board approved
23	adding morning rush hour service last fall. We
24	come back to you today in a different and more

uncertain situation. Staff are recommending at 1 the current time that the Board approve a one-year 2 3 extension of the current pilot service through 4 June of 2021. With the pandemic affecting all CTA service and deeply depressing movement of all 5 kinds, and, therefore, transit use, this is not a 6 7 propitious time to make permanent changes to the 8 CTA system, even for a well-received route like 9 It will continue to serve our customers this. 10 well; and given the region's status in the COVID 11 spectrum, considerations of what the CTA system will look like post pandemic are best left to 12 future discussions and future decisions by the 13 14 Staff are therefore recommending that the Board. Board approve the ordinance before you, which 15 16 would extend the current route operation for one 17 year from mid June of 2020 through mid June of 18 2021. Thank vou. I would be happy to answer
