## **Budget Balanced**

- No service cuts or fare increases
- Increase revenue streams
- Reduce expenses further
- Federal stimulus infusion of capital funds

## Stimulus Project Update

- Blue Line Dearborn Subway \$88M
  - Work began on April 17, 2009
- New hybrid, articulated buses \$50M
  - First of 58 buses to arrive in June
- Bus and Rail Car Rehabilitation- \$75M
  - Underway since stimulus was announced

  - 149 of the153 bus routes will be available

  - Available Summer 2009











# April Ridership Results: 43.3M Rides





## Ridership Growth Across the Area


- Ridership growth still very strong on North Side, near Northwest, and near West Sides.
