AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING THE DISCHARGE AND DISMISSING THE COMPLAINT OF NATHAN GRAY

WHEREAS, Following his discharge from the Authority, Nathan Gray requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 77-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on April 23, 2003; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board reviewed and considered the hearing committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the report of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Nathan Gray, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the October 1, 2003 Executive Session of the Finance, Audit and Budget Committee meeting.

SECTION 2. That the Section 28 complaint filed by Nathan Gray following his discharge on February 11, 2003 is hereby dismissed. Nathan Gray's discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
