

ORDINANCE NO. 003-144

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE
AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO
KIEWIT-REYES, A JOINT
VENTURE, FOR REHABILITATION
OF 9.4 MILES OF THE DAN RYAN
BRANCH OF THE RED LINE FROM
CERMAK-CHINATOWN TO 95TH
STREET

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority wishes to rehabilitate 9.4 miles of the Dan Ryan Branch of the Red Line from Cermak-Chinatown to 95th Street, and

WHEREAS, The work shall include rehabilitation of seven rapid transit stations, replacement of escalators, platform canopies, lighting, floor finishes, sidewalks, and the installation of elevators, and

WHEREAS, Additionally, the work shall also include replacement of existing special trackwork and contact rail, upgrade of traction power including the construction of two new substations, new signal system, and new communication infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Funding and performance of this project shall be divided into three phases: Phase I is allotted for 40% (\$76,999,200.00) of the contract amount, Phase II is allotted for 40% (\$76,999,200.00) of the contract amount, and Phase III is allotted for the remaining 20% (\$38,499,600.00) of the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, Through a competitive bidding process, four responses were received on August 22, 2003; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that it is in the Authority's best interest to authorize award of this contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Kiewit-Reyes, Joint Venture; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Kiewit-Reyes, A Joint Venture, for the rehabilitation of 9.4 miles of the Dan Ryan Branch of the Red Line from Cermak-Chinatown to 95th Street, in the amount not to exceed one hundred ninety-two million, four hundred ninety-eight thousand dollars (\$192,498,000.00), as described in Requisition C03FR1661.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
