ORDINANCE NO. 003-65

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO CHANGE THE NAMES OF TWO STATIONS ON THE CERMAK (DOUGLAS) BRANCH OF THE BLUE LINE

WHEREAS, The Authority is reconstructing the Cermak (Douglas) Branch of the Blue Line: and

WHEREAS, The Authority seeks to provide clear station signage for its customers; and

WHEREAS, The stations previously named "Hoyne" and "Kildare" have been physically modified so that the main entrances will be constructed at the opposite ends of the platform from the old stations; and

WHEREAS, The new station entrances will be closer to Damen and Kostner Streets, respectively; and

WHEREAS, The station designs have been approved under the Full Funding Grant Agreement with the Federal Transit Administration; and

WHEREAS, Community input has been obtained by staff on the proposed station name changes; now, therefore:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chicago Transit Board of the Chicago Transit Authority hereby authorizes the Chicago Transit Authority to change the names of the two stations now called "Hoyne" and "Kildare" to "Damen" and "Kostner," respectively.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
