ORDINANCE NO. 003-47

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE INTERNET ACCESS INCLUDING E-MAIL CONNECTIONS ON A DEDICATED SERVER FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-FOUR MONTHS

WHEREAS, The Authority is connected to the Internet by an optical fiber link to RCN Telecom Services of Illinois, Incorporated ("RCN"); and

WHEREAS, All Internet traffic to and from CTA travels over this link; and

WHEREAS, RCN Internet computer servers are located on the sixth floor of the Apparel Center, the building that also houses the CTA computer center; and

WHEREAS, The close proximity of CTA computer equipment and RCN Internet computer servers has made it possible for RCN to establish a fiber optic link between RCN computers and CTA computer equipment, at no initial purchase or installation cost or ongoing maintenance cost to CTA; and

WHEREAS, It would be advantageous to CTA to continue to utilize RCN as its Internet service provider given the close logistical location of the respective computer systems; and

WHEREAS, It would be detrimental for the Authority to change Internet service providers, due to down time and CTA cost associated with the establishment of a fiber optic link to a new service provider were the Authority to change Internet service providers; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive bidding for this service is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with RCN Telecom Services of Illinois, Incorporated, to provide Internet access, including E-mail connections on a dedicated server, for a period of twenty-four months, in the not-to-exceed amount of one hundred ninety-two thousand dollars (\$192,00,00) under requisition B02OP01125.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
