

ORDINANCE NO. 003-43

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
WITH THE CITY OF CHICAGO FOR THE
DESIGN OF A RAPID TRANSIT STATION
AT WASHINGTON AND WABASH
STREETS IN THE LOOP ELEVATED

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") and the City of Chicago ("City") are undertaking a project to construct a new rapid transit station at Washington and Wabash Streets in the Loop elevated; and

WHEREAS, This project is entirely funded by the Regional Transportation Authority ("RTA"), under which the Authority will be allowed to pass-through one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to the City for services performed; and

WHEREAS, The Authority desires to cooperate with the City on this construction project, which will afford improved amenities for its passengers; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (Contract C02RT1340) with the City of Chicago by and through its Department of Transportation for construction assistance services for the new rapid transit station at Washington and Wabash Streets in the Loop elevated, which will include the following:

- a. CDOT shall provide 30% complete design engineering services for a newly accessible rapid transit station at Washington and Wabash Streets.
- b. The CTA and CDOT shall agree with the conceptual and/or schematic designs for the work prior to CDOT authorizing each design phase to begin.
- c. CDOT shall coordinate design reviews with the CTA, and all comments made by the CTA must be responded to in writing by CDOT to the satisfaction of the CTA. The CTA's General Manager, Facilities Engineering, must approve each stage of design prior to CDOT advancing to the next stage.

- d. CDOT shall attend conferences with representatives of the CTA and other interested agencies as may be required in connection with the project.
- e. CDOT shall submit a monthly progress report stating the work completed in the current month and the projected work to be completed in the next month.

SECTION 2. That the Chicago Transit Authority shall pass-through an amount not to exceed one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to the City of Chicago for services performed.
