AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXERCISE OF A CONTRACT OPTION FOR GUARD SERVICE FOR CTA'S COLLECTION SERVICES VAULT OPERATIONS, REVENUE EQUIPMENT TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT, AND WAREHOUSE OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, In January 2000, the Authority entered into contract B99OP000877 with All Points Security & Detective, Inc., for guard service for CTA's Collection Services Vault Operations, Revenue Equipment Technology Department, and Warehouse Operations; and

WHEREAS, In November 2002, staff solicited pricing to replace this contract; and

WHEREAS, The pricing for the option provision of the current contract is 7.7% lower than the pricing received in response to the solicitation; and

WHEREAS, There is sufficient funds available to support approximately ten months at current service levels; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that it is in the Authority's best interest to exercise the option with All Points Security & Detective, Inc.; now, therefore:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute such documents with All Points Security & Detective, Inc., necessary to effectuate the exercise of option under Requisition B99OP00877.

SECTION 2. That the Transit Board hereby authorizes the addition of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) for the cost of this option, for a total contract value of \$2,893,900.00.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its passage.
