

ORDINANCE NO. 002-168

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING THE
DISCHARGE AND DISMISSING THE
COMPLAINT OF EFRAIN VILLARREAL

WHEREAS, Following his discharge from the Authority in October 11, 2001, Efrain Villarreal requested a timely hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act 70 ILCS 3605/28; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 87-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on January 17, 2002; and

WHEREAS, A second day of hearing was held on February 18, 2002; and

WHEREAS, A transcript was made of the proceedings; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board reviewed and considered the hearing committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the report of the hearing committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Efrain Villarreal, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the November 14, 2002, executive session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. That the Section 28 complaint filed by Efrain Villarreal following his discharge of October 11, 2001, is hereby dismissed. Efrain Villarreal's discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
