

ORDINANCE NO. 002-132

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN
AGREEMENT WITH CONSOER
TOWNSEND ENVIRONDYNE
ENGINEERS, INC., FOR BROWN LINE
RENOVATION CONSTRUCTION
MANAGEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Authority requires construction management services for the Brown Line expansion and Clark junction project; and

WHEREAS, The Authority requires that construction management services be performed during both the pre-construction phases and construction phases of the project; and

WHEREAS, The CTA solicited letters of interest and qualification for these construction management services in accordance with its Purchase and Sales Regulations and Administrative Procedure 145 which describes the qualifications-based process for selection of professional engineering and architectural services; and

WHEREAS, Consoer Townsend Environdyne Engineers, Inc., was selected as the most qualified respondent; and

WHEREAS, Contract negotiations with Consoer Townsend Environdyne Engineers, Inc., have been successful; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Chicago Transit Board hereby authorizes award of a contract to Consoer Townsend Environdyne Engineers, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$22,338,979.53 to be authorized as follows: Phase I not to exceed \$2,313,515.23 and Phase II not to exceed \$20,025,464.30.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Consoer Townsend Environdyne Engineers, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$22,338,979.53 under Requisition No. C02FI1214.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
