

ORDINANCE NO. 002-131

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACTS
APPROVED BY THE CHICAGO
TRANSIT BOARD

WHEREAS, Contracts originally approved by the Transit Board now require approval of assignment of contracts; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of said Board is authorized to approve the following assignment of contracts:

1.1 Contract C01RT8031

Original Ordinance No. 002-95

Description: Purchase two (2) multi-purpose hook-lift trucks with salt spreaders, flat beds, dump bodies, and snowplows

The Chicago Transit Authority entered into a contract with Freightliner, Sterling, Western Star on July 10, 2002, for two multi-purpose hook-lift trucks with salt spreaders, flat beds, dump bodies, and snow plows. These trucks are multi-purpose as their bodies can readily be changed by replacement with one of the three bodies provided, i.e., salt spreader, dump, and flat bed bodies. The trucks are also equipped with removable snowplows. On July 3, 2002, subsequent to the Board meeting, Freightliner of Chicago, Inc., advised CTA that it terminated its Freightliner franchise and assigned this contract to its new franchise dealer, Northwest Freightliner, Sterling, Western Star. Northwest Freightliner, Sterling, Western Star has indicated to CTA in a written letter its desire to continue the relationship with CTA under this contract. It is recommended that the subject contract be assigned to Northwest Freightliner, Sterling, Western Star.
