

ORDINANCE NO. 002-118

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING  
ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACTS  
APPROVED BY THE CHICAGO  
TRANSIT BOARD

WHEREAS, Contracts originally approved by the Transit Board now require approval of assignment of contracts; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of said Board is authorized to approve the following assignment of contracts:

- 1.1 Contract B02OP00114  
Original Ordinance No. 002-78

*Description: Genuine Cummins parts for a period of twenty-four months*

The Chicago Transit Authority entered into a contract with Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago on June 17, 2002, for genuine Cummins parts for a period of twenty-four months. These genuine Cummins parts are used as repair parts on Cummins diesel engines that power the Flxible and Nova buses. On June 3, 2002, Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., purchased the assets and operating authority of Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago. Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., has indicated to CTA in a written letter its desire to continue the relationship with CTA under this contract.

Original Ordinance No. 001-152

*Description: Cummins L10 and M11 engine rebuilding for a period of twenty-four months*

The Chicago Transit Authority entered into a contract with Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago on November 15, 2001, for Cummins L10 and M11 engine rebuilding for a period of twenty-four months. These test engines were installed in Flxible buses. On June 3, 2002, Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., purchased the assets and operating authority of Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago. Chicago Truck Sales & Service has indicated to CTA in a written letter its desire to continue the relationship with the CTA under this contract.

Original Ordinance No. 001-68  
*Description: Genuine General Motors parts for a period of twenty-four months*  
The Chicago Transit Authority entered into a contract with Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago on May 10, 2001, for genuine General Motors parts required for the maintenance and repair of CTA's non-revenue General Motor's vehicles. On June 2, 2002, Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., purchased the assets and operating authority of Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago. Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., has indicated to CTA in a written letter its desire to continue the relationship with the CTA under this contract.

Original Ordinance - "C" Agenda dated 5/19-5/31/01  
*Description: Repair parts for White Motor Corporation trucks for twenty-four months*  
The Chicago Transit Authority entered into a contract with Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago on June 27, 2001, for repair parts for White Motor Corporation trucks for a period of twenty-four months. These parts are required for the maintenance and repair of CTA's non-revenue White Motor Corporation trucks which are used system-wide. On June 2, 2002, Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., purchased the assets and operating authority of Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago. Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., has indicated to CTA in a written letter its desire to continue the relationship with CTA under this contract.

- 1.5 Contract B01OP01233  
Original Ordinance - "B" Agenda dated 11/16-11/31/01  
*Description: Air, oil, and fuel filters for non-revenue vehicles for a period of twenty-four months*  
The Chicago Transit Authority entered into a contract with Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago on December 3, 2001, for air, oil, and fuel filters for non-revenue vehicles for a period of twenty-four months. These filters are used on non-revenue vehicles such as trucks, automobiles, forklifts, loaders, scrubbers, sweepers, etc. On June 3, 2002, Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., purchased the assets and operating authority of Volvo & GMC Trucks of Chicago. Chicago Truck Sales & Service, Inc., has indicated to CTA in a written letter its desire to continue the relationship with CTA under this contract.
