AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF A LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR A CTA BUS PASSENGER SHELTER LOCATED ON WEST GRAND AVENUE, AT NORTH LECLAIRE AVENUE, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") currently has over 1,000 bus passenger shelters located throughout the Chicago area for the protection of the transit riding public from inclement weather; and

WHEREAS, Authority bus passenger shelters are located on the City of Chicago's public way, on property owned by other units of local government and on private property; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has licensed certain property located on West Grand Avenue, at North Leclaire Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, to maintain one (1) aluminum frame bus passenger shelter since 1979; and

WHEREAS, Chicago Transit Board Ordinance No. 95-10 authorized the execution of an Extension of License Agreement between Commonwealth Edison Company, as Licensor, and the Chicago Transit Authority, as Licensee, for use of the subject property effective December 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS, Said License Agreement expired on November 30, 1999, and the Authority requires continued use of the property to maintain a bus passenger shelter for riders of the #65 Grand bus route indefinitely; and

WHEREAS, Staff has negotiated an extension of the License Agreement for property located on West Grand Avenue, at North Leclaire Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, which shall permit continued use of the property by the Authority for bus passenger shelter purposes for a term of five (5) years; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an extension for License Agreement between Commonwealth Edison Company, as Licensor, and Chicago Transit Authority, as Licensee, for the property located on West Grand Avenue, at North Leclaire Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, further described on Exhibit "A" for use by the Authority to maintain one (1) aluminum frame bus passenger shelter.

SECTION 2. That said License Agreement shall extend for a term of five (5) years, commencing December 1, 1999, and ending November 30, 2004. Said agreement will also include a waiver of license fee, a short term cancellation provision, a provision to permit the Authority to self-insure for this location, an indemnification of Commonwealth Edison Company by the Authority and such other terms which are substantially in conformance with the other terms set forth in Exhibit "B".

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
