

ORDINANCE NO. 97-28

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN
AMENDMENT TO AN INTERGOVERNMENT
AGREEMENT WITH CITY OF CHICAGO
FOR DEVELOPMENT OF TRANSIT-
ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT PLANS FOR
SELECT GREEN LINE STATIONS

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 94-67, passed May 6, 1994, the Chicago Transit Authority entered into an intergovernmental agency agreement with the City of Chicago wherein the City would provide for the development of transit oriented development plans at four selected Green Line elevated stations; and

WHEREAS, Due to unforeseen changes in project management and increased community involvement, the project has been delayed beyond the anticipated completion date; and

WHEREAS, Additional time is required for the City of Chicago to complete work to carry out the development plans; and


WHEREAS, The Authority desires to continue to work with the City to complete this project; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute amendment number 1 to contract G940P 01036 with the City of Chicago to extend the completion date to December, 1997 to complete the development of transit-oriented development plans at selected Green Line elevated stations. There is no increase in expenditures against this contract.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
