ORDINANCE NO. 97-20

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING
THE DECISION OF THE HEARING
COMMITTEE TO UPHOLD THE
DISCHARGE OF CHARLES TOMCZYK

WHEREAS, Charles Tomczyk requested a hearing pursuant to Section 328 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 77-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, On June 19, August 19, and September 17, 1996 hearings were held on the complaint filed by Charles Tomczyk; and

WHEREAS, On January 22, 1997, the Committee's Report Findings and Recommendations were presented to the Transit Board in executive session; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Report of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint filed by Charles Tomczyk, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the January 22, 1997, executive session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. That the Transit Board finds the discharge of Charles Tomczyk was for cause which was detrimental to the service.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
