

ORDINANCE NO. 97-8

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING
PRIOR BOARD APPROVAL FOR
HEALTH MAINTENANCE
ORGANIZATION PLANS FOR
CTA EMPLOYEES AND RETIREES
FOR FIVE YEARS

WHEREAS, By Ordinance No. 96-113, passed October 16, 1996, the Transit Board authorized award of a contract to three health maintenance organization plans for services to employees and retirees for a period of five years effective January 1, 1997; and

WHEREAS, Subsequent to the award, the Authority was advised by Rush Prudential Health Care Plans that they were withdrawing their "best and final" proposal dated September 26, 1996; and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interests of the Authority to have the Board rescind its approval for award of a contract to Rush Prudential Health Care Plans; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Transit Board hereby rescinds that portion of Ordinance No. 96-113, duly passed October 16, 1996, authorizing award of a contract for a health maintenance organization plan to Rush Prudential Health Care Plans for a five year period commencing January 1, 1997, under requisition B96OP 80525.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
