WHEREAS, following his discharge from the Chicago Transit Authority, Joseph Ramirez requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 88-81, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a Hearing Committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on November 14, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Chicago Transit Board reviewed and considered the Hearing Committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The report of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the Complaint of Joseph Ramirez, together with the transcript of the proceedings, post-hearing briefs and exhibits, shall be made a part of the minutes of the August 12, 2015 Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. The Section 28 Complaint filed by Joseph Ramirez following his discharge on March 4, 2014, is hereby dismissed. Joseph Ramirez' discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
