

ORDINANCE NO. 98-35

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
THE TERMINATION OF CONTRACT
AND THE RE-AWARD OF CONTRACT
FOR REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT
OF STORAGE TANKS AT 63RD
STREET LOWER YARD AND KEDZIE
BUS FACILITY

WHEREAS, On October 22, 1997, the Chicago Transit Board passed Ordinance No. 97-122, authorizing an award of a contract to the lowest bidder, R. Rudnick, for the removal and replacement of storage tanks and pumping, distribution and dispensing systems at the Authority's 63rd Street Lower Yard and Kedzie Bus Facility.

WHEREAS, Subsequent to the award of the contract, R. Rudnick notified the Authority's Purchasing Department that their bid would have to be withdrawn due to an estimating error and that wold not honor the contract.


WHEREAS, Purchasing Department contacted the second lowest bidder, Mosbeck Industrial Equipment, and requested they extend their bid price. Mosbeck agreed and their bid price was extended until April 30, 1998; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Mosbeck Industrial Equipment, under contract C97FR 6971, in the amount of Two Million Six Hundred Forty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$2,643,900.00).

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect form and after its passage.
