ORDINANCE NO. 98-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL VISITOR'S PASS FOR ONE, TWO, THREE AND FIVE DAYS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Board, on June 11, 1997, adopted Ordinance 97-86 authorizing the development of a special visitor's pass experimental demonstration project; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the experimental demonstration project was to broaden the ridership base in specific markets and to encourage public transit use by visitors to Chicago; and

WHEREAS, In the experimental demonstration project visitors were offered a one day visitor's pass; and

WHEREAS, Staff elicited public comment during the course of the experimental demonstration project; and

WHEREAS, The results of this public comment and operational data support the feasibility of continuing with a special visitor's pass program and expanding the program to include one, two, three and five day passes; now, therefore:

> BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chicago Transit Board hereby authorizes one, to, three and five day Special Visitor's Passes.

SECTION 2. The price of the Special Visitor's Passes shall be as follows:

One	Day	Pass	-	\$5.00	Three Day Pass -	\$12.00
Two	Day	Pass	-	\$9.00	Five Day Pass -	\$18.00

SECTION 3. The Chairman, upon consultation with the President, shall determine the number of hours each day the pass shall be valid and may increase or decrease the number of days a pass can be used.

SECTION 4. The President of the Authority, or his designee, shall develop a program for the sale of the passes to include hotels and museums and such other locations as the President deems appropriate. The President is also directed to determine if the payment of a sales commission is appropriate and to set the rate of commission. ORDINANCE NO. 98-25 (Continued)-2

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
