

ORDINANCE NO. 98-21

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING THE
DECISION OF THE HEARING
COMMITTEE TO UPHOLD THE
DISCHARGE OF THADDEUS WILLIAMS

WHEREAS, Thaddeus Williams requested a hearing pursuant to Section 328 of the Metropolitan Transit authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 87-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, On November 19, 1997, December 3, 1996 and January 3, 1997, hearings were held on the complaint filed by Thaddeus Williams; and

WHEREAS, On February 20, 1998, the Committee's Report Findings and Recommendations were presented to the Transit Board in Executive Session; now, therefore:


BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The report of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint filed by Thaddeus Williams, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the February 20, 1998, Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. The Transit Board finds the discharge of Thaddeus Williams was for cause which was detrimental to the Service.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
