ORDINANCE NO. 99-112

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING IN PART THE COMPLAINT AND OVERTURNING THE DISCHARGE OF CHARLES LINDENMUTH

WHEREAS, Following his discharge from the Authority, Charles Lindenmuth requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 77-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on December 11, 1998, January 18, 1999, January 28, 1999 and February 24, 1999; and

WHEREAS, A transcript was made of the proceedings; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board reviewed and considered the hearing committee's recommendation; now, therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the report of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Charles Lindenmuth, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the July 21, 1999 Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. That the Section 28 Complaint filed by Charles Lindenmuth following his discharge on October 29, 1998, is hereby sustained in part. Charles Lindenmuth's discharge shall be reduced to a thirty (30) day suspension. He shall be immediately returned to his position as an At-Large Manager at a location and shift to be determined by management.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
