ORDINANCE NO. 99-124

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRIBUTION OF MAPS AND BROCHURES TO VARIOUS HOTELS, CORPORATIONS AND ATTRACTIONS TO MAKE CTA SERVICE INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO VISITORS AND TOURISTS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority is in need of distribution service to provide CTA service information at various sites throughout the CTA operating area; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has identified Central Brochure Distributors as the source able to distribute brochures to the greatest number of hotels and businesses in the area; and

WHEREAS Central Brochure Distributors has contracts with over 191 hotels and businesses in the Chicago area in which to deliver brochures; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive bidding for this service is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to award a contract to Central Brochure Distributors to provide distribution service to 191 outlets, at the total amount of twenty three thousand two hundred twenty dollars (\$23,220.00) under Requisition B99OP01186.

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SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
