ORDINANCE NO. 99-97

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO CENTRAL BUSINESS MACHINES FOR WORK PERFORMED

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority awarded a contract to Central Business Machines to repair and perform preventive maintenance on typewriters; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority authorized Central Business Machines to perform typewriter repair work after the contract expiration and Central Business Machines did perform the repair work; and

WHEREAS, Central Business Machines was in the unique position of having performed the work, it is disadvantageous to consider a contractor other than Central Business Machines to provide this service; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

Section 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive bidding for this service is disadvantageous.

Section 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to approve payment to Central Business Machines for work performed, in the amount of five hundred seventy-three dollars and sixty-eight cents (\$573.68) under Requisition C99OP02254.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
