ORDINANCE NO. 99-96

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT WHICH PROVIDES PAYMENT OF REPAIR WORK PERFORMED BY WALTER PAYTON POWER EQUIPMENT, LLC.

WHEREAS, Repairs were needed to a CTA truck crane used by CTA personnel to deliver material for maintenance and repairs along CTA rapid transit right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, A contract is in place between CTA and Walter Payton Power Equipment, LLC. for rental of track maintenance equipment; and

WHEREAS, The Authority authorized repair work to the truck crane by Walter Payton Power Equipment, LLC. thinking that such repairs would be included in the scope of the existing equipment rental agreement; and

WHEREAS, The rental contract does not include compensation for repair work performed on CTA equipment; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive public bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive public bidding for this service is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract which provides for payment to Walter Payton Power Equipment, LLC in the amount of one thousand one hundred eighty-seven dollars and forty cents (\$1,187.40) under Requisition C99OP02258.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
