ORDINANCE NO. 96-113

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION PLANS (HMOS) FOR CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY EMPLOYEES AND RETIREES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") offers certain benefits to its employees and retirees, including health care; and

WHEREAS, In order to continue to provide its employees with the best health care plans, the staff issued "Request for Proposal" and in response thereto received eight responses; and

WHEREAS, After evaluation of the proposals, staff has identified three plans which offer services that would be in the best interest of the employees and retirees; now, therefore:

> BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to retain the services of the following health maintenance organizations to provide health care services for its employees for a period of five years commencing January 1, 1997:

Humana Health Care Plans	-	Req.	B960P	80525A
Rush Prudential	-	Req.	B960P	80525B
HMO Illinois	-	Req.	B960P	80525C

SECTION 2. That expenditures and payments to each of the HMO providers will depend on the total employee enrollment in each Plan.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
