AN ORDINANCE DISMISSING THE COMPLAINT OF RICHARD BAKO

ORDINANCE NO. 96-110

WHEREAS, Richard Bako requested a hearing pursuant to Section 328 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 77-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, On September 14, 1995 a hearing was held on the complaint filed by Richard Bako; and

WHEREAS, On September 11, 1996 the Committee's recommendation that the complaint be dismissed based on the representation that all issues in controversy had been resolved was presented to the Transit Board in executive session; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the recommendation of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint filed by Richard Bako, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the September 11, 1996, executive session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. That the Transit Board finds that the issues in controversy have been resolved and that the complaint filed by Richard Bako is hereby dismissed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
