

ORDINANCE NO. 006-103

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING  
THE DISCHARGE OF  
JERMAINE WESLEY DAY

WHEREAS, Following his discharge from the Authority, Jermaine Wesley Day requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 88-81, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on April 6, 2006; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board reviewed and considered the hearing committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The report of the hearing committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Jermaine Wesley Day, together with a transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the August 9, 2006, Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. The Section 28 complaint filed by Jermaine Wesley Day following his discharge on January 19, 2006, is hereby dismissed. Jermaine Wesley Day's discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
