ORDINANCE NO. 006-107

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CHICAGO AND THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FIBER AND VIDEO IMAGES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority"), has installed fiber optic strands along its transit lines and has security cameras at its facilities; and

WHEREAS, The City of Chicago ("City") has installed fiber optic strands throughout the City, along with security cameras; and

WHEREAS, This intergovernmental agreement allows the City and the Authority the right to use a limited amount of each other's dark fibers and to access live and recorded video images for government purposes only; and

WHEREAS, Both the right to use the fiber and to access live and recorded video images would be provided at no cost to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Authority to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City in the form attached to this ordinance; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman, or her designee, is authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Chicago, granting the Authority the right to use a limited number of City dark fibers and to access the City's live and recorded video images, and granting the City the right to use a limited number of the Authority's dark fibers and to access the Authority's live and recorded video images. The intergovernmental agreement shall be substantially in conformance with Exhibit A, attached hereto.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
