AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING THE DISCHARGE OF ARTURO BECERRA

WHEREAS, Following his discharge from the Authority, Arturo Becerra requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 88-81, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on April 12, 2006, and May 9, 2006; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board reviewed and considered the hearing committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The report of the hearing committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Arturo Becerra, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the December 13, 2006, Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. The Section 28 complaint filed by Arturo Becerra following his discharge on June 7, 2005, is hereby dismissed. Arturo Becerra's discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
