AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL 2007 JOB ABOLISHMENTS AND REDUCTIONS IN FORCE

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transit Authority Act, 70 ILCS 3605/28 ("Act"), grants to the Board the authority to "abolish any vacant or occupied office or position"; and

WHEREAS, The Act grants the Board the authority to "reduce the force of employees for lack of work or lack of funds as determined by the Board"; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has presented a recommendation to the Board that it abolish the following ten (10) positions, in which there currently are fourteen (14) employees: Quality Assurance Analyst II (one employee); Coordinator, Production Control (two employees); Network Support Specialist II (one employee); Coordinator, Engineering – Computer Systems (two employees); Coordinator, Information Technology Education (one employee); Manager, Revenue Equipment Technology (one employee); Project Coordinator, Technical (two employees); Senior Project Manager (two employees); Coordinator, Shop Operations (one employee); and Funding Strategies Officer (one employee); and

WHEREAS, The Authority has presented a recommendation to the Board that it reduce the force of one (1) Service Desk Controller position; and

WHEREAS, The Board has discussed and reviewed the recommendation of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, The Board desires to maintain the highest levels of economy and efficiency within the Authority; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Board approves the abolishment of the following positions: Quality Assurance Analyst II; Coordinator, Production Control; Network Support Specialist II; Coordinator, Engineering – Computer Systems; Coordinator, Information Technology Education; Manager, Revenue Equipment Technology; Project Coordinator, Technical; Senior Project Manager; Coordinator, Shop Operations; and Funding Strategies Officer positions; and the reduction in force of the Service Desk Controller position; and the Board directs the President to take all appropriate steps to effectuate these staffing changes within a reasonable time.

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SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the above, nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to conflict with the rights of employees as set forth in the Act or any employee covered by a collective bargaining agreement.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
