

ORDINANCE NO. 001-43

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
RTA AND METRA EMPLOYEES USE
OF CTA EMPLOYEE
IDENTIFICATION CARDS FOR
RIDING PRIVILEGES ON CHICAGO
TRANSIT AUTHORITY
TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chicago Transit Board hereby authorizes and directs the Chicago Transit Authority Treasurer to enter into an agreement with and between the Chicago Transit Authority, Regional Transportation Authority and Metra for the purposes of permitting Regional Transportation Authority and Metra for the purposes of permitting Regional Transportation Authority and Metra personnel to utilize employee identification cards for riding privileges on Chicago Transit Authority services.

SECTION 2. The Chicago Transit Authority Board determines that the sum of seven hundred eighty dollars (\$780.00) per card represents fair compensation from the Regional Transportation Authority and Metra in consideration for the extension of such riding privileges for up to twenty six (26) Regional Transportation employees and eight (8) Metra employees during calendar years 2001-2002.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, by-laws, rules and regulations establishing rates and charges for use of transportation facilities and services not inconsistent with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. The President, or his designee, is hereby authorized to take such action as deemed necessary or appropriate to implement, administer and enforce said agreement.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
