AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING
THE DISCHARGE AND
DISMISSING THE COMPLAINT
OF ANTHONY WILLIAMS

WHEREAS, Following his discharge from the Authority, Anthony Williams requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 87-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on May 1, 2000, May 5, 2000, June 8, 2000 and June 19, 2000; and

WHEREAS, A transcript was made of the proceedings; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board reviewed and considered the hearing committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the report of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Anthony Williams, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the March 7, 2001, executive session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. That the Section 28 complaint filled by Anthony Williams following his discharge of January 24, 2000, is hereby dismissed. Anthony Williams' discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
