ORDINANCE NO.009-134

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
DISADVANTAGEOUS TO PUBLIC
BIDDING CONTRACT FOR
COMPREHENSIVE MEDICAL/
PHYSICAL EXAMS AND DRUG
TESTING SERVICES

WHEREAS, The City of Chicago (City) prepared and publicly advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) and successfully contracted for comprehensive medical/physical exam and drug testing services commencing April 2009 with Occu-Sports Med. Corp. d/b/a Advanced Occupational Medicine Specialists (AOMS); and

WHEREAS, The City's contract with AOMS has a three year term with one three-year option to extend; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (Authority) requires the same scope of services; and

WHEREAS, The City has been satisfied with the work performed by AOMS and, due to its size, the City was able to negotiate favorable pricing for the needed services; and

WHEREAS, The Authority wishes to take advantage of the work the City has done in procuring this vendor; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has determined that AOMS is the company that best meets its needs and that it would not be in the best interest of the CTA to further seek competitive bids for this type of professional services; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts of this type and amount by the Transit Board "such other matters, for which the Board determines that competitive bidding is disadvantageous"; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby provides approval for the Authority to execute a contract for comprehensive medical/physical exams and drug testing.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Occu-Sports Med. Corp. d/b/a Advanced Occupational Medicine Specialists to provide the professional services required in the amount not-to-exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00), under requisition No. B10OP03585.
