

ORDINANCE NO.009-135

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
PROCUREMENT OF CUBIC
TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS
AUTOMATED FARE COLLECTION (AFC)
EQUIPMENT FOR THE REHABILITATION
OF THE GRAND/STATE STATION

WHEREAS, The Authority desires to acquire the Cubic Transportation Systems equipment as part of the rehabilitation project for the Grand/State – Red Line subway station; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT) is currently upgrading and rehabbing the Grand/State – Red Line subway station; and

WHEREAS, The requested equipment is part of the Authority's overall expansion project of AFC equipment within rehabilitated CTA stations; and

WHEREAS, Cubic Transportation Systems, Inc. is the developer, manufacturer and copyright holder of the proprietary equipment, and therefore the sole-source available to provide the requested equipment and spare parts; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-1 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts "where the goods or services to be procured are procurable from only one source"; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that the goods and services to be procured are procurable from only one source.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cubic Transportation Systems, Inc. for the procurement of the Automated Fare Collection (AFC) equipment, in an amount not to exceed four hundred ninety-nine thousand eight hundred fifty-three dollars and forty cents (\$499,853.40), under Requisition No. C09OP100896759.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
