ORDINANCE NO. 009-138

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF JOHN BOUMAN AS A TEMPORARY MEMBER OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD

WHEREAS, John Bouman was appointed a temporary member of the Chicago Transit Board, effective November 12, 2009, by Governor Pat Quinn; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bouman has taken and subscribed the constitutional oath of office and has filed it in the Office of the Illinois Secretary of State and all other requirements of Section 20 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act, 70 ILCS 3605/20 have been met; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The appointment of John Bouman, as a temporary member of the Chicago Transit Board, is hereby made a matter of record upon the permanent files of the Authority.

SECTION 2. The salary of John Bouman, as a temporary member of the Chicago Transit Board, is hereby fixed at a rate of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) per annum. He shall also be entitled to any current and future benefits available under existing and future insurance and retirement plans available to employees, officers, or Board Members of the Authority.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
