

ORDINANCE NO. 009-123

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING  
AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT  
APPROVED BY THE CHICAGO  
TRANSIT BOARD

WHEREAS, Contracts originally approved by the Chicago Transit Board now require approval of contract amendments; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of said Board, or his designee, is authorized to approve the following amendment:

- 1.1 Contract B09OP09049 – Giesecke & Devrient America, Inc.  
Original Ordinance No. 008-177  
*Description: Purchase of encoded and un-encoded smart cars with graphics from Giesecke & Devrient America, Inc. (G&D) for use with the CTA Automated Fare Collection (AFC) system to be released as required*  
Amendment No. 1 provides for the costs associated with G&D storing the up to two million chips for the duration of the contract. The cost for that storage is \$0.015 per chip. In addition, if any of the million chips remain after July 2010, the CTA will purchase the remaining chips at a cost of \$0.75 per chip.

**Revised contract amount - \$28,775,000.00**
