ORDINANCE NO. 010-90

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AN E-MAIL AND DIGITAL SUBSCRIPTION SERVICE

WHEREAS, The Authority continues to require a system to electronically communicate with its large customer base, via E-mail or pager, concerning planned or emergency delays, reroutes or other pertinent information; and

WHEREAS, The Authority requires this system to be tailored to its unique requirements; and

WHEREAS, The Authority requires an electronic communication system, which does not require any additional hardware, software, database installation or programming requirements on the Authority's network; and

WHEREAS, The Authority requires full control over the content provided to our customers; and

WHEREAS, The Gov Delivery, Inc., GovDelivery E-mail and Digital Subscription Management program fulfills all of the Authority's requirements with an easy to implement, turnkey system; and

WHEREAS, The Gov Delivery, Inc. system is the only known system available that will allow the Authority to provide E-mail and digital subscription service without requiring that third-party content management software be added onto the Authority's network; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive bidding for this service is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Gov Delivery, Inc. in a not-to-exceed amount of ninety thousand six hundred thirty-nine dollars and thirty-six cents (\$90,639.36), under Requisition No. B10OP03283.
