

ORDINANCE NO. 011-9

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
PURCHASE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
SUPPORT SERVICES FROM MULTIPLE
VENDORS REFERRED TO AS TECHNOLOGY
RESOURCE ACQUISITIONS FOR PROGRAMS
OF REGIONAL TRANSIT ("TRANSPORT") FOR
A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS WITH TWO
ONE-YEAR OPTIONS (CATEGORY ONE)

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("CTA") is in need of Information Technology ("IT") Support Services to enable various CTA user departments to accomplish their IT objectives; and

WHEREAS, CTA wishes to develop a pool of vendors which will allow for a broader range of services and solutions to fulfill the majority of IT services needed at CTA; and

WHEREAS, The multiple award of contracts will be referred to as CTA TRANSPORT and will be comprised of five comprehensive functional service categories; and

WHEREAS, This award is for Category One – Communications Infrastructure Engineering Design, Development, Implementation, and Integration; and

WHEREAS, The vendors identified on Exhibit A were selected to participate in Category One and will provide all phases of system design and development through deployment; and

WHEREAS, The specific requirements will be identified and defined as task orders that will be awarded through competitive bidding between the firms listed on Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that CTA enter into a three year agreement with two one-year options with the vendors identified on Exhibit A, now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby authorizes award of a three year contract with two one-year options to the twelve vendors identified on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

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SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with each of the vendors listed on Exhibit A for Information Technology support services under requisition C10FR101029694.

SECTION 3. That the Chicago Transit Board further approves the list of projects identified on Exhibit B as the projects to be completed under work/task orders to be issued to the recommended firms listed on Exhibit A based on competitive bidding between these qualified firms.

SECTION 4. That all work/task orders shall be subject to further prior written approval by the Chairman and President.

SECTION 5. That CTA management shall provide the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board with a monthly report of the status of each project identified on the list of projects provided for each of the five categories.

SECTION 6. That the total cost of CTA TRANSPORT (Category One) is Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000).

SECTION 7. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
