ORDINANCE NO. 012-51

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING THE DISCHARGE OF DORETHA BANKS

WHEREAS, Following her discharge from the Chicago Transit Authority, Doretha Banks requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 88-81, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on September 29, 2011, and October 19, 2011; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Board has reviewed and considered the hearing committee's findings and recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The report of the hearing committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Doretha Banks, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the May 9, 2012, Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. The Section 28 complaint filed by Doretha Banks following her discharge on July 29, 2011, is hereby dismissed. The discharge of Doretha Banks is sustained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
