- 1. Interior LED lighting. At the request of CTA, the contractor changed the florescent lighting to LEDs for environmental and maintenance reasons.
- 2. Advance payment and receipt of eight (8) additional Series 5000 rail cars.
- 3. Contract value unchanged

Change Order No. 2 amends the agreement between CPS and CTA to authorize CPS, with CTA's approval, to enter into Parking Agreements and License Agreements for the installation and maintenance at CTA-owned parking lots, of electric vehicle charging stations with Illinois-licensed car-sharing companies. Any such Parking and License Agreements with car-sharing companies will have expiration dates of December 31, 2014, concurrent with CTA's master contract with CPS.
