ORDINANCE NO. 013-102

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A LEASE OF RETAIL CONCESSION SPACE LOCATED AT 219 SOUTH DEARBORN STREET, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS (BLUE LINE)

WHEREAS, The Authority owns property located at 219 South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois, which contains approximately 149 square feet of retail concession space available for lease; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has contracted with Jones Lang LaSalle Americas Inc. ("JLL"), to lease this space; and

WHEREAS, Through extensive marketing and competitive negotiations, JLL has identified Sandwiches, LLC, which is owned by Sam Rosenberg, as a viable tenant for the space ("Tenant"); and

WHEREAS, The primary use of the space will be for the operation of a sandwich shop; and

WHEREAS, The parties negotiated a ten (10) year lease with one ten (10) year renewal option and an escalating rent schedule; and

WHEREAS, Tenant will be responsible for all applicable taxes and utility fees; and

WHEREAS, Tenant will indemnify the Authority for its use of the leased space; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Transit Board of the Chicago Transit Authority, or his designee, is authorized to enter into a retail lease agreement with Sandwiches, LLC for retail concession space in the Blue Line station at 219 South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois.

SECTION 2. The lease has a term of ten (10) years with one ten (10) year renewal option; an initial annual rent of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per square foot with four percent (4%) annual increases; and requires indemnification of the Authority.

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SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
