

ORDINANCE NO. 014-131

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING  
EXECUTION OF A COLLECTIVE  
BARGAINING AGREEMENT  
CONTAINING THE TERMS OF AN  
INTEREST ARBITRATION AWARD  
AND A TENTATIVE AGREEMENT  
WITH THE INTERNATIONAL  
BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL  
WORKERS UNION,  
LOCAL 134 – ROADMASTERS

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transit Authority Act (70 ILCS 3605/28a) provides that the Chicago Transit Board has the right to deal with and enter into collective bargaining agreements with employees represented by a labor organization; and

WHEREAS, The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Union, Local 134 (the "Union") is the bargaining agent for certain roadmasters employed by the Chicago Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority and the Union have reached a tentative agreement on the non-wage terms of a new four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement (also known as the Wage and Working Conditions Agreement) effective January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, The wages to be paid under the new four year Wage and Working Conditions Agreement have been established pursuant to Arbitrator Elliott H. Goldstein's Interest Arbitration Award ("Award"); now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a Wage and Working Conditions Agreement with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Union, Local 134 – Roadmasters, with an expiration date of December 31, 2015. Said Wage and Working Conditions Agreement shall reflect the terms of the Award and the tentative agreement between the Chicago Transit Authority and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Union, Local 134 - Roadmasters.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
