

ORDINANCE NO. 015-24

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING
ALTERNATES TO THE BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF THE RETIREMENT
PLAN FOR CHICAGO TRANSIT
AUTHORITY EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, The Illinois Pension Code, 40 ILCS 5/22-101 *et seq.* directs the Chicago Transit Board (the "Board") to appoint five trustees to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees; and

WHEREAS, The bylaws for the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees allow for the appointment of alternates; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 011-96, dated September 14, 2011, appointed Judith Kelley as an alternate to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 013-92, dated July 15, 2013, appointed Carol Rubin as an alternate to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees; and

WHEREAS, It is recommended that David Biggs and Sharon Weiler be appointed to replace Judith Kelley and Carol Rubin as alternates to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act, 70 ILCS 3605/17, the Authority may provide for the indemnification of any officer or employee of the Authority against loss or damage to property from any cause in the performance of the duties of his/her office or employment; and

WHEREAS, The Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the Authority to indemnify the aforementioned appointees and any successor appointees or alternates to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. Effective immediately, the Transit Board hereby appoints David Biggs and Sharon Weiler as alternates to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees. These alternates and any successor alternates shall have all duties and responsibilities conferred upon them pursuant to the legislation creating the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees and any amendments thereto.

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SECTION 2. If any claim or action is instituted against any trustee, successor trustee or alternate to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees based on harm or damage allegedly arising out of any act or omission of any such trustee, successor or alternate occurring within the scope of his/her appointment or work on behalf of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees, the Authority shall indemnify such trustee, successor trustee or alternate for all legal expenses, court costs and for any amount paid pursuant to any judgment on, or any good faith settlement of such claim, except for any portion of a judgment awarded for willful or wanton misconduct.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be deemed to be and shall constitute a contract between the Authority and the trustee, successor trustee or alternate to the Board of Trustees of the Retirement Plan for Chicago Transit Authority Employees.

SECTION 4. The Board retains the authority to modify this appointment at any time.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
