SECTION 1. The Chairman of said Board, or her designee, is authorized to approve the following contract change orders:

- 1.1 Contract C05FR100254533 Aldridge-Mass, A Joint Venture Original Ordinance No. 005-173 Description: Install new train control system from the Forest park Terminal of the Congress Branch of the Blue Line through the Dearborn Subway to the Jefferson park Station on the O'Hare Branch of the Blue Line Change Order No. 15 provides for the following:
 - Jefferson Park to Central 12 conductor cable CTA directed the contractor to install approximately 2,500 feet of new signal cable containing 12 conductors, instead of the original 5 conductors, in a two inch high-density polyethylene conduit to be buried underground. \$67,381.00
 - 2. Delete NEMA-4 slack enclosures Elimination of 22 stainless steel slack enclosures at each end of eleven station platforms to accommodate extra fiber optic cable Credit (\$5,858.00)
