AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT CONTAINED IN REQUISITION NO. B06OP01790, ILLINOIS STATE POLICE, FOR THE PURCHASE OF USER ACCESS TO A SECURED LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY DATABASE SYSTEM FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO 60 MONTHS

WHEREAS, The Law Enforcement Agency Data System (LEADS) is a secured database operated by the Illinois State Police; and

WHEREAS, This database provides authorized users access to criminal, vehicle, and driver's license information and other computerized law enforcement information 24 hours per day; and

WHEREAS, These services are of vital importance to the Office of the Inspector General (OIG); and

WHEREAS, The investigators of the OIG were granted police powers by CTA Ordinance 000-75 and are authorized to utilize the LEADS system on behalf of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois State Police agreement presented to staff for access to the LEADS database requires the Authority to indemnify the Illinois State Police for any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, and proceedings, including, but not limited to, any liabilities for damages by reason of, or arising out of, any false arrest or imprisonment or any cause of action whatsoever as a result of the use of this database; and

WHEREAS, Due to the indemnification agreement contained in the contract document, staff now seeks Board approval for entry into a contractual agreement with the Illinois State Police; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Illinois State Police to provide user access to a secured database for a period of 60 months from date of contract in the not-to-exceed amount of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00), under Requisition B06OP01790. The Authority is authorized to indemnify the Illinois State Police for any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, and proceedings, including, but not limited to, any liabilities for

damages by reason of, or arising out of, any false arrest or imprisonment or any cause of action whatsoever as a result of the use of this database as set forth in the contract agreement.
