

ORDINANCE NO. 006-187

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
EXECUTION OF A COLLECTIVE
BARGAINING AGREEMENT
CONTAINING THE TERMS OF THE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND
THE OPERATING ENGINEERS,
LOCAL 399

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transit Authority Act (70 ILCS 3605/28a) provides that the Chicago Transit Board has the right to deal with and enter into collective bargaining agreements with employees represented by a labor organization; and

WHEREAS, The Operating Engineers, Local 399, is the bargaining agent for approximately six engineers; and

WHEREAS, On Monday, November 27, 2006, the Chicago Transit Authority and the Operating Engineers, Local 399, reached a tentative agreement on the terms of a new, 3-year Collective Bargaining Agreement (also known as the Wage and Working Conditions Agreement) with its member units effective January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2006; now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Wage and Working Conditions Agreements between the Chicago Transit Authority and the members of the Operating Engineers, Local 399, with an expiration date of December 31, 2006. Said Wage and Working Conditions Agreement shall reflect the terms of the November 27, 2006, tentative agreement between the Chicago Transit Authority and the Operating Engineers, Local 399, as ratified by the Operating Engineers, Local 399.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, and/or the President of the Chicago Transit Authority, or his designee, shall be authorized to apply such terms of the above-referenced Wage and Working Conditions Agreement as they deem appropriate to non-bargained-for employees of the Chicago Transit Authority.
